TECHNICAL & SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE



INTENDED USE- KRIS CLOT dental material is used as a haemostatic in case of capillary bleeding, for gum retraction when making imprints and treating cervical caries, for prophylaxes purpose and for treating root canals in case of apical bleeding.

COMPOSITION: Ferrous sulphate, Aluminium chloride, centimonium bromide, etc.

DESCRIPTION: KRIS CLOT are applied without spreading on mucosa. The main component of "KRIS CLOT" materials is aluminum chloride (i.e. haemostatic) which intensifies centimonium bromide featuring bactericidal effect and for quicker homeostasis, materials are not toxic and can be easily used. The materials do not feature irritation effect and are easily washed off. Haemostatic Liquid material on Fe basis can change color of gum tissue for 1-2 days.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE: Sterile cotton wad smeared with KRIS CLOT should be applied under pressure to bleeding surface for 1 minute. In case of strong bleeding, the part of gum to be treated should be isolated with cotton wad. Some Liquid should be applied for 1 minute. The retraction cord wetted with "Re-cord" liquid should be applied to provide stronger haemostatic. Then Liquid should be washed off and gum should be dried with airflow. For root canal treatment, Liquid is introduced into canal by means of paper point or root needle for one minute. Then the canal should be washed with solution of sodium chloride and dried out.

CONTRAINDICATIONS: Kris Clot is not to be used on patients having a history of allergy reactions to type sensitivity to Fe, Al compounds.

WARNING : Avoid prolonged inhalation. Do not take internally Contact with the skin may cause irritation, burns of hypersensitivity. If contact with skin occurs immediately wipe off thoroughly with cotton and alcohol and then wash well with soap and water. If skin rash and sensitization or other allergic reaction occurs discontinue use and seek medical attention. If the product comes into contact with the eyes, rinse thoroughly with fresh water and consult a physician.

RECAUTIONS FOR USE: Always replace cap immediately after use, keep syringe in dry place below 25°C.

STORAGE CONDITIONS: The product should be stored below 25°C.

DISPOSAL CONDITIONS: To be disposed off based on the prevailing rules of the country in which it is used.
